**RESIDENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS** "Resident" is defined as being a person living in the Parish of Coggeshall.

Residential qualifications comprise:

- EITHER (1) at the time of death, the deceased was resident;  
OR (2) the person owning or purchasing exclusive right of burial is a resident;  
OR (3) in the case of a stillborn child, either parent is a resident,  
OR (4) the deceased was a resident for five or more years but became non-resident involuntarily, for example by the need to receive residential care in another area during the period immediately prior to the date of death.

FOR PERSONS WHO DO NOT MEET THE ABOVE CRITERIA CONCERNING RESIDENCE FEES IN PART 1 and 2 ( INTERMENTS and EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS) WILL BE DOUBLED.

**MEMORIAL TREES IN SECTION E**

Cost of dedication of a memorial tree	£150
Period of dedication	15 years

The memorial trees in Section E may be dedicated for a set period of years on payment of the appropriate fee. This may be renewed by the payment of the fee in force at the time of renewal.

A memorial plaque may be supplied and placed by the purchaser of the tree. The size, material and wording will be subject to Council approval and must be submitted for approval before installation.
