### **A120 Marks Farm to Marks Tey**

I am writing to provide you with details about maintenance work we will soon be carrying out on the A120 Marks Farm to Marks Tey on behalf of Highways England. This scheme forms part of a wider package of works to deliver essential maintenance and improvements on A12, A11, A14 and A120 in Essex and Suffolk.

This work involves resurfacing, renewal of road markings and the replacement of road signage.

We will start this work on **13 November** and plan to be finished on **18 December**.

We will be working overnight: **Monday - Wednesday 8pm- 6am.**  
**Thursday 9pm- 6am**

And weekends: **Friday 8pm to Monday 6am.**

### **Traffic restrictions**

To complete this work safely and minimise disruption to the travelling public there will be overnight carriageway closures in place on the A120 Marks Farm to Marks Tey. During this time a clearly signed diversion route will be in place via the A120 Pannors Interchange towards the B1008/A131/A130 Junction, and then onto A1016/A130 Roundabout to the A130 then to A12 Junction 19, back to A120 Junction 25 Marks Tey.

### **Access to properties**

Only those needing access to properties or businesses within the closure extents that cannot access properties via an alternative route will be allowed access. All other drivers must use an alternative route. Gatemens will not permit access to people who want to travel through the closure area and out the other side.

We apologise for the inconvenience but these works are essential. There are numerous operatives working at the closure points but please be patient. **It is important that you wait for our escort to take you in/out of the closure and do not proceed alone.** This procedure is to ensure both your safety and that of our workforce, and ignoring it will put all involved at risk.

We have written to local residents to inform them of these maintenance works and we would be grateful if you would publicise the details to your parishioners through newsletters and other communications where appropriate.
