

**FULL COUNCIL MEETING: 29<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2021**  
**CLERK'S REPORT**

**1. Conservative Club Licensing Application**

The extension requested to allow the Council to comment was disallowed.

**2. Screening Opinion – Proposed Solar Photovoltaic Farm and Associated Infrastructure**

The Council could not be granted an extension to comment on the Screening Opinion because there is a shorter statutory period for determining screening opinions.

However, a full planning application will be required before the proposed development can go forward and Coggeshall Parish Council will be able to make comment at that time.

**3. Request for Free Use of a Market Stall by Big Park Project Fund Raiser**

A member of the fundraising group for the Big Park Project has requested to be permitted to 'rent' free of charge a space for a stall at the Market on Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> April to sell merchandise to fundraise for the Project. The request for the stall to be free of charge is based on the grounds that the BPP will be of benefit to the community.

**4. Unsafe Bench**

A bench on the corner of St Anne's Close and St Peter's Road is currently unsafe to sit on as it leans over when used. Our Maintenance Officers have sealed it off and it has been reported.

**5. Queen Street Fence Railings**

The Maintenance Officer has found out who is responsible for the railings in Queen Street which are leaning over towards the pavement and the matter is in hand.

Any other matters will be reported on orally at the Meeting.
