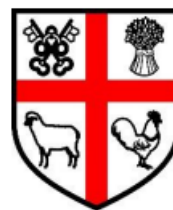


Cemetery Fees

- Exclusive Right of Burial (EROB) Term: 50 years
- Fees for coffin burial do not include cost of grave-digging. Please arrange via your undertaker.
- A permit must be granted for all memorials, replacement and additional inscriptions.

Memorial Permit Fees

- Fees are for the Memorial Permit only, which must be granted for all new memorials, replacements and additional inscriptions, prior to installation.
- An application form must be submitted to the Parish Council prior to purchase of your memorial.
- Memorial stone and kerbs permissible in Sections A – D only.
- Memorial stone only permissible in Section E.

Transfer of EROB Ownership	£70

Notes

Residential Qualifications

To qualify as a resident, one of the following criteria must be met:

- The deceased was resident within the civil parish of Coggeshall, at the time of death.
- The deceased was resident in Coggeshall for five or more years prior to the time of death, but moved involuntarily, e.g. to move to a place of residential care.
- In the case of a child (under the age of 18), either parent lives in Coggeshall.

Previous residents may qualify, with each enquiry dealt with on its own merits. If so, previous resident fees are charged at double the rate of the fees listed above.
